

B-Entrepreneur aims to support access to the most innovative and validated best practices in training and education in the field of entrepreneurship developed within the framework of the EU LLP 2007 - 2013. The project will contribute towards reaching the EU2020 and the Entrepreneurship Action Plan objectives regarding the need for entrepreneurial education to promote a more competitive EU.

Status of the Project

As we shared with you in our 1st Newsletter, a large number of LLP projects were about to be examined by each partner within the project team. The projects to be reviewed were categorised under three main themes:

1. Entrepreneurship in disadvantaged groups
2. Best practices in training methodologies in entrepreneurship
3. Best practices in accompanying measures

Every project was reviewed and a classification, based on objective numeric criteria, was established. This preliminary desk research has led to a total amount of 75 projects being identified for further analysis and review. This follow-up will take place with experts in the field of entrepreneurial education in each partner country, in order to define and present the best practices available across Europe in this field.

The Online Library

The Interactive Online Library, where the best practices in entrepreneurship will be showcased will come online in summer 2015 and will continue to be hosted by Adesema until 2018 making the project results available to the benefit of stakeholders, project managers, policy makers and practitioners across Europe for years to come.

Where we are now...

In early December, the project team met in Prerov, Czech Republic to define and agree the criteria to be used to select the best 75 projects from a pool of more than 300 examples. As a result of this work, 75 LLP projects have been selected and, by now, each partner is gathering additional information directly from the project managers in order to facilitate an expert appraisal process in the New Year.
